The International Tashir chess tournament has opened

On November 3, the opening ceremony of the international Tashir chess tournament in memory of Tigran Petrosian was held. The ceremony was hosted by the film director, actor and TV anchor Tigran Keosaian.During the opening ceremony, the film 'The Iron Tigran' about Tigran Petrosian was shown; this was followed by the legend of Armenian chess, the grandmaster Rafael Vaganian, who informed the audience of Tigran Petrosian's 'Chess Lectures' that had been reprinted by Tashir Group in honour of the present tournament.

The President of FIDE Kirsan Ilyumzhinov greeted the audience and awarded the Tigran Petrosian Medal to the Chief Arbiter of the tournament Boris Postovsky (USA) for his outstanding coaching achievements in the past.
