Samvel Karapetyan: Person of the Year-2011

On December 14th the Person of the Year 2011 award ceremony took place in Christ the Saviour Cathedral in Moscow. The ceremony was organised by the Russian Biographical Institute, Institute of Economic Strategy and the Orthodox Businessmen Club.
